






#### Where we're at now:



#### What is the Indieweb?

A people-focused alternative to the commercial web

- Your content is yours, not a corporate silo
- You are better (inter)connected between services
- You are in control, you can do what you want
- Your domain is your primary identity

## Some of the concepts

- Own your data on your own site/blog/webpresence
- Use the tools you make
- Open Source
- Have fun



#### Some (technical) concepts

- Microformats > Markup for data, text, people, events
- Indieauth > Federated login protocol to sign in with your own domain on other services
- Webmentions > Comment on a blogpost through your own site
- Micropub > Publish on your own domain with 3rd party software
- Microsub > Own your feed-subscriptions
- ActivityPub > Decentralized Networking Protocol

## POSSE principle

Publish (on) Own Site, Syndicate Elsewhere

# My experiments in my social presence



- Building my own blog in <u>Jekyll</u>
- Removed Facebook (trackers, consuming vs producing)
- Unfollowed everyone on Twitter. And restarted from scratch
- Examining decentralization/indieweb principles

#### Decentralized (Smart) Alternatives

- Twitter/Facebook > <u>Mastodon</u>
- Whatsapp > Signal or Telegram
- Instagram > Pixelfed
- Gmail > Fastmail or Protonmail
- Google > Startpage or DuckDuckGo
- Medium > Known, Jekyll, WordPress selfhosted
- Closed API's > ActivityPub
- Chrome browser > Beaker Browser (p2p & .dat protocol)
